Value-based payments are intended to incent providers to:

- Improve health outcomes for their attributed/assigned membership.
- Reduce utilization and cost of health care services that are of little to no benefit to the patient or could be provided in more cost-effective settings.
- Improve member experience in the care process.

These outcomes can be realized by improving your care model, enhancing internal adherence to that model, enhancing timely and convenient access to your services, addressing barriers that make it difficult for your patients to comply with their treatment plan, or building collaborative relationships with external health care providers who offer complementary services to yours.
